Comprehension - Listening

- Understands simple vocabulary related to self, school, family and hobbies.
- Understands simple instructions in class.
- Listens and pays attention.

Comprehension - Reading

- Knows the Icelandic alphabet and Icelandic phonemes.
- Can read and understand simple words and sentences.
- Practice reading.

Tjáning - Talað mál, samskipti og frásögn

- Practicing spoken language.
- Can ask for help.
- Can introduce him/ herself, greet, say goodbye and thank you.
- Knows basic vocabulary, level 1 words: can name words for objects, colours, people, days, numbers and animals and simple sentences about daily activities.
- Can describe an object with simple words and preparation.

Expression - Writing

- Can write the alphabet.
- Can write his/her name, address and school name.
- Can write individual words and sentences.

Icelandic as a second language - level 2

Comprehension - Listening

- Understands simple conversations.
- Understands instructions during lessons.
- Practices subject vocabulary.

Comprehension - Reading

- Can read and understand text from study materials with the support of aids.
- Can guess the meaning of individual words based on context in simple text.
- Can follow the plot of short stories and narratives in simple language.

Expression - Spoken language, communication and narration

- Can participate in conversations and discussions.
- Can ask simple questions.
- Can answer questions.
- Practice talking about things.
- Can talk about how he/her feels.
- Can communicate with others about the subject.
- Can prepare a short presentation.
- Can describe people, places and things in a simple way.

Expression - Writing

- Can write simple text that others can understand.
- Can write short descriptions.
- Can answer questions in writing.
- Can create a short introduction.
- Can write short, simple narratives.
- Practice grammar and spelling.

Icelandic as a second language - level 3

Comprehension - Listening

- Understands everyday conversations fairly easily.
- Understands the main content of discussions and education related to the study.
- Has a fairly good knowledge of the subject vocabulary.

Comprehension - Reading

- Can read textbooks for his/her own benefit.
- Can find key information in a text to solve an assignment.
- Can read long stories.

Expression - Spoken language, communication and narration

- Can participate in long conversations and discussions.
- Can describe things or events in detail.
- Can express his/her feelings and opinions.
- Can prepare and deliver a presentation on a topic.

Expression - Writing

- Can write continuous text.
- Can write academic essays.
- Can write a continuous story with a beginning, sequence of events and ending.
- Has acquired a foundation in Icelandic grammar and applies it in writing.
